

Items for orthographic constraint test from Treiman (1993). See p. 167-170 for discussion

<b>Nonword pair (correct answer listed second)</b>	<b>Constraint tested</b>
ffeb, beff	Consonant doublets do not usually occur at the beginnings of words
ddaled, dalled	same as above
yikk,yinn	<i>kk</i> rarely occurs
vayying, vadding	<i>yy</i> does not occur
ckun, nuck	<i>ck</i> does not occur at the beginnings of words
ckader, dacker	same as above
vaad, vadd	<i>aa</i> rarely occurs
muun, munt	<i>uu</i> rarely occurs
iit, ist	<i>ii</i> rarely occurs
moyl, moil	digraphs ending in <i>y</i> do not usually occur before consonants
awt, aut	digraphs ending in <i>w</i> do not usually occur before consonants
bei, bey	digraphs ending in <i>i</i> do not usually occur at the ends of morphemes
dau, daw	digraphs ending in <i>u</i> do not usually occur at the ends of morphemes
gri, gry	<i>i</i> does not usually occur at the ends of morphemes
yb, ib	<i>y</i> as a vowel does not usually occur at the beginnings of words
chym, chim	<i>y</i> as a vowel does not usually occur in the middles of morphemes
